WMC Continues Baseless Attack on Penny Bernard Schaber

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MADISON - With momentum clearly on Penny Bernard Schaber's side in the 19th state Senate district, Scott Walker's reliable henchmen at Wisconsin Manufacturers and Commerce have swooped in with a completely false television attack ad that lies about Penny's record in office.
