GREEN BAY - We learned today that Ashwaubenon Village President **Mike Aubinger** has died. According to local

, Ashwaubenon clerk/treasurer Patrick Moynihan Jr. made the announcement Friday morning.

Only yesterday, we learned from the <u>Green Bay Press Gazette</u> that Aubinger had taken an indefinite leave of absence for medical reasons. Aubinger had been ill for several weeks before submitting a letter on Monday requesting leave.

Aubinger, who suffered from melanoma, a type of skin cancer, was replaced on an interim basis by Trustee Mary Kardoskee as village president.

Green Bay State Senator **Dave Hansen** released the following statement on the local leader:
