NEENAH, WI - Mike Ellis, a man who spent more than forty years of his life dedicated to Wisconsin politics, passed away Friday morning a family member told <u>Action 2 News</u>.

He served from 1970 until 2014 in the Legislature, a tenure that spanned eight governors and began when current Gov. Scott Walker was just 3 years old.
