Legislation threatens safety of drinking water; removes local public control over Wisconsin's water systems. Press Conference on Water Privatization Bill scheduled for Wednesday, February 3rd in Green Bay.

GREEN BAY - On Wednesday, Senator **Dave Hansen** will join community leaders from Wisconsin League of Conservation Voters and Sierra Club to call on the Wisconsin State Senate to reject a bill that threatens drinking water for millions of Wisconsinites and opens the door to corporate control of Wisconsin's water systems.



This legislation benefits the private water industry while removing the transparency and accountability that allows citizens and local elected officials to ensure safe drinking water. Senator Hansen, representatives from Wisconsin League of Conservation Voters, Fox Valley Sierra Club, and additional community members will be available for comment after short prepared remarks.
