I wrote the president, my senators and representatives and all my state legislators. Only one senator responded to my request.

When I returned home I suffered with PTSD. Unable to keep a job, I filled a Comp & Penn. The DOD denied my claim. They couldn't find my records. Once again I wrote to my elected officials and once again only one senator responded.

Four days after I sent a letter to Sen. Russ Feingold's office, every single one of my military records arrived at my doorstep. The DOD dragged its feat on my Comp & Penn claim, and once again Feingold's office stepped up.

Since then I have helped about a dozen veterans file claims for injuries sustained in the combat zone. Every time we ran into a road block, we wrote to Feingold, and every time his office followed through.
