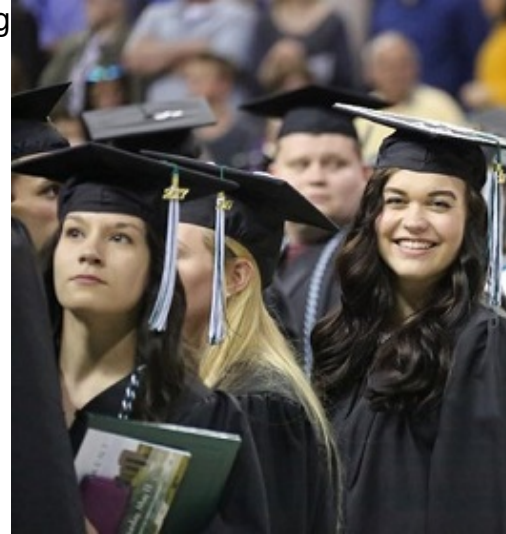


Generational Gaslighting
