In wake of Florida school shooting, Senate GOP votes against safety plan funding on Tuesday.

MADISON, WI – In seeking to provide more protections for students, teachers and staff at local schools, Senate Democrats introduced an amendment that would provide revenue limit exemptions for expenditures made under a school safety plan.
