

MILWAUKEE - We interview State Representative Sara Rodriguez, Citizen Action's endorsed candidate for Lt. Governor in the fast approaching August 9th primary election. Sara tells us about her background in healthcare as a nurse and administrator and why she is the best running mate for Tony Evers.
