

Milwaukee Police hassle Buck's guard Sterling Brown, Foxconn production plans, worker legal rights in the workplace, and Leon Young's sudden decision not to run.

Walker, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistic reports that Minnesota had more total jobs than Wisconsin in 2017 for the first time in recent history and added more jobs each year for the last 10 years.
